To Whom it may concern,

This document is to certify that **Dr. Stefan-Gregore Ciornei** is recognized by the AETE as the national embryo transfer data collector of **Romania**.

The duties of a national data collector include collection of commercial embryo transfer data in domestic animal species (embryo production both in vivo and in vitro, and embryo transfers, as well as embryo export and embryo technologies) from teams/ practitioners operating in the country and submission of the data to the Association of Embryo Technology in Europe, AETE. **Dr. Stefan-Gregore Ciornei certifies that the submission of these data will be according to the AETE guidelines, standards and timing.**

AETE publishes annually in September the report of European embryo activities. The data is submitted by AETE to the International Embryo Technology Society, IETS, which collates the data in the worldwide statistics. Report of IETS Data Retrieval Committee is published annually in December. AETE acts, when managing this data collecting activity, according to the GDPR rules. For more info, refer to www.AETE.eu .
